6. Pebble Beach Community Services District (PBCSD)/Cal Fire

General Manager Niccum stated focus is on the normal planning process for the annual fuel reduction program. He detailed efforts in the Huckleberry Hill "toothpick forest" area that have brought it far more up to standards in 15 years since the 1987 fire considering environmentally sensitive habitat area treatment restrictions. a. Shawn Casey reported that bike ramps have been disassembled and unauthorized trails removed in the notorious areas of the forest. Peter Brown, Director of PBC Security stated that patrol of trailheads and trail use is irritating bikers indicating that efforts are having some effect.

Chair Ogle reported there is final direction to place the Red Trail on the ocean side of Stevenson Drive; he requested marking be placed to delineate the finalized trail route to which Shawn stated he would do after the AT&T Pro-Am. PBC has done a great job of clearing the Blue Trail in the Poppy Lane area; one or two directional posts are needed.

- b. Kelly Getreu will provide information to PBC of trail maintenance needs to the degree possible while dealing with injuries she recently suffered.
